



Aberlour 10 year old

A sweet ‘sherry and honey’ nose, balanced by spiciness and a touch of Jaffa oranges. Caramel and quite dry Sherry on the palate, with barley sugar in the medium-long sweet finish.

Ardbeg 10 year old

Quite sweet on the nose, with soft peat, carbolic soap and Arbroath smokies. Intense yet quite delicate on the palate, with burning peats and dried fruit, followed by sweeter notes of malt and a touch of liquorice. Extremely long and smoky in the finish, with a fine balance of cereal sweetness and dry.

Balvenie Doublewood

A smooth and mellow single malt of beautifully combined flavours. Nutty sweetness, cinnamon spiciness and a delicately proportioned layer of sherry, with a long and warming finish.

Bowmore 12 year old

Nose: Fresh heather, fruit, honey, nuts and oak wood.

Taste: This expression cleverly captures fruit, honey, heather and spice notes, against a backdrop of mellow oak wood, in a fresh and lively combination.



Bruichladdich Bourbon Cask

Nose: Fresh and fruity. Soft vanilla, stone fruit. Peppery, oaky.

Palate: Estery, vanilla, spice. Apples, pears.

Finish: Long, crisp finish, fruit.

Bruichladdich Waves

Wave after wave of complex flavours are revealed - cranberry, raisin, vanilla, peat-smoke - creating a vibrant yet sweet dram, with just a hint of fresh ocean spray.

Bunnahabhain 12 year old

Nose: Remarkably fresh, sweet, sea-air and perfume.

Palate: Gentle, clean, nutty-malty sweetness.

Bushmills 10 year old

Nose: Very lightly scented with nutty ice cream and sherry.

Palate: Rich dried fruit and chewy toffee, quite a mouth filling shock after the very delicate nose.

Cardhu

A much loved single malt, Cardhu is an easy going charming speysider, with clean oak and sweet malt evoking flavours of honeyed flapjacks and home made caramel squares, this is one for the sweet toothed among you.

Clynelish 14 year old

It's the texture that makes this dram: a creamy, velvety mouthfilling sweetness, with a slightly metallic finish. Lots of tropical fruits, a thread of smoke and scented candle character on the nose.

Cragganmore 12 year old

A soft start, then dark fruits mixed with light honey and cooked peach. A rich, elegant, silky texture that fills the mouth.

Deanston 12 year old

Deanston 12 years old is a fine mellow malt with a fragrant, fruity flavour and a lingering sweet aftertaste.

Dalmore 12 year old

Fusing together the sweet vanilla whiskies from ex bourbon barrels with aromatic and spicy dried fruit characters from Spanish sherry casks.

Dalmore 15 year old

A rich aromatic heart full of dried spices, cloves, cinnamon and ginger with a concentrated citrus mouth-feel to tantalise your tongue and an abundant aftertaste of spice.

Dalwhinnie 15 year old

Dalwhinnie 15yo is a good introduction to the delights of single malt whisky - elegant, smooth and medium-bodied with a light, fruity palate and a whiff of heather on the finish.

Dailuaine 16 year old

Smooth and rich with warming syrupy flavours and an almost meaty smokiness give way to lighter notes of tinned peaches and sponge fingers.

Edradour 10 year old

The palate is dry and marked by the spices (pepper and mint) and the cereals. The finish, rather long has an elegant fruity sweetness. A pleasant malt with a nice presence..

Fettercairn

The colour is gold. The nose is characterised by sherry, nut and peat hints. The taste of nuts is rather dry, and some toffee hints make it sweeter. This whisky is well balanced, and the very pleasant finish is slightly perfumed.

Fettercairn FIOR

Honey gold in colour with aromas of crushed peat, toffee apple and hints of cinnamon and vanilla. A kiss of peat and smoke with hazelnuts, orange rind, ginger and coriander complete the nose. Taste is of bold dark chocolate, roasted coffee beans and peat smoke laced with nutmeg mint, citrus fruits and truffle.

Glenfarclas 10 year old

Wonderful combination of biscuit and cream, with hints of peat and perfume. Very satisfying!

Glenfarclas 15 year old

A rich gold-amber with a luscious, unctuous oily oak character delicately peated. Finish gloriously sherry sweet, gently smoky-long and distinguished.

Glenfarclas 105

The colour is gold with copper glints, the nose is strong and reveals dry fruit and toffee. The palate is sweet and powerful, marked by honey hints. The finish is dry, long and warming.

Glenfiddich 12 year old

Nose: Light and malty/mealy. Some citric notes (lemon/orange peel). Water opens up the nutty cracker bread maltiness alongside some dry grass and dried apple.

Palate: Soft with vanilla, malt, a light nuttiness and a soft mid-palate.

Finish: Soft and lightly fruity with a hint of chocolate.

Glengovne

A fresh, delicate nose and a light golden colour indicates lightness and subtlety. A refined, well balanced malt scotch whisky in taste, made all the more rewarding by its unpeated style and light, yet complex taste. Sweet and malty.

Glenkinchie 12 year old

Nose: Very aromatic and flowery overall, like breathing in a country garden. Noticeable vanilla, cut flowers and beneath these, a clean, toasty note. Becomes increasingly sweet and creamy, with a lightly aromatic edge and fresh citrus, which all brings to mind lemon cheesecake.

Glenlivet 12 year old

Nose: Lifted. Apple wood, heather, baked soft fruits mixed with cereal, citrus and pear. In time there's notes of freshly-sawn wood, freesia and dried orange peel. **Complex but light as well. Palate:** Light and fragrant. All the notes on the nose come through. Medium-bodied and gentle.

Glenmorangie 10 year old

Velvet textured with delicate, honeyed overtones and a burst of citrus softening into vanilla and almonds.

Glenmorangie Quinta Ruban

A remarkable malt, antique gold in colour: golden but with a rosy hue. This whisky has been matured for at least 12 years in American white oak casks and racked for several years into Ruby Port pipes for 'finishing'.

Glenmorangie LaSanta

The full, sweet flavour typical of Spanish sherry with sultanas, orange segments, walnuts and butter toffee. The bite of hazelnut tasted through a chocolate coating, spice notes and hints of leather add the overwhelming sense of richness

Glenmorangie Nectar D'or

Infused with the signature honey, citrus and spice aroma of the Sauternes dessert wine that lingers in the wooden casks, the result is a whisky of exquisite sophistication and complexity.

Glenrothes Select Reserve

Pale gold in colour, with a bouquet of American oak, vanilla and coconut, with the nearest hint of plums. The palate is full and malty, medium sweet, with vanilla and orange zest.

Glenturret 10 year old

The new 10 year old from Glenturret has arrived! Its existence has been rumoured for some time but now it's here to replace the 12 year old.

Highland Park 12 year old

Nose: Smoky, "garden bonfire" sweetness, heathery, malty, hint of sherry. **Palate:** Exceptionally smooth. Succulent, with smoky dryness, heathery-honey sweetness and maltiness.

Isle of Jura 10 year old

Much more upfront, fresher malt than on the nose with a light, though chewy, oakiness. A spicy dryness offers some pizzazz.

Jura Superstition

Palate : Light smoke lying above firm, young grassy notes. Beech nuts, heather. Silky feel

Finish : Good length. Drifting smoke.

Knockando 12 year old

On the nose, Knockando is light and nutty/malty with some green pear, straw, dry spices. Estery and crisp. **On the palate** it is equally light and nutty with a touch of milk chocolate in the mid-palate. Soft, easy and ultra-clean with a crisp, short and dry finish.

Lagavulin 16 year old

Nose: Lapsang Souchong and fruity sherry.

Palate: The dryness is at first offset by the sweetness of the sherry character. As the palate develops, oily, grassy, and, in particular, salty notes emerge in a long, sustained, aggressive, attack. **Finish:** A huge, powerful, bear-hug of peat.

Laphroig 10 year old

Nose: Phenolic - seaweedy - very peaty with a hint of sweetness.

Palate: Richly smoky, fully peated with a hint of salty-sweetness.

Ledaig

Medium to full bodied. Distinctive peaty, smoky taste with gorgeous floral flavours.

Longmorn 15 year old

A terrific full-blooded Speysider, oozing complexity with plenty of spice, sweet fruits, heather and balanced oak interplaying with the malt. A highly-respected whisky with a loyal following.

Macallan 10 year old

The 10 Years Old is matured exclusively in Spanish oak sherry casks, to deliver a deep, rich, deliciously smooth and well-rounded flavour, with a slight sweetness and touch of sherry and wood. Its deep colour, like that of all of its siblings, is achieved wholly naturally without the addition of any colouring.

Macallan 18 year Old

The 18 year old adds amazing complexity to the 10 year old - a lovely sherried whisky, and a bit of a benchmark for this style. This is an absolute classic and a must-try for anyone learning about malt.

Monkey Shoulder

Beautifully sweet with a rich vanilla flavour, the taste is brown sugar and creamy toffee balanced with oak notes and just a hint of spice(cinnamon and nutmeg).

Oban 14 year old

The colour is deep yellow. The nose, light, refined and balances is marked by spices (pepper), citrus fruits and light woody and smoky hints. The palate is smooth and develops on peat with a smoky, malty finish with exotic fruit touches.

Old Pultney 12 year old

It has hints of apple, vanilla, oak, chocolate and Battenberg cake, giving it great complexity of flavour. Soft and delicate

Scapa 16 year old

Despite being an Island whisky, Scapa has a soft, easy character . Gingerbread, nutmeg, vanilla and butterscotch aromas combine with a hint of sea air while the palate begins with very light, creamy vanilla and crème caramel, evolving with citrus and a hint of sea spray and digestive biscuits

Singleton

The sweet and fruity notes in this fine malt from Dufftown, at the heart of Speyside, are the product of traditional, slow distilling using pure water from Highlandman John's Well. Long maturation in a unique balance of European and American Oak then gives the The Singleton of Dufftown its smooth, richly satisfying taste.

Speyburn 10 year old

Nose : Elegant and light. Vibrant gingerbread. Spicy. Stewed apricot. A hint of toasted almonds. Palate : Smooth and soothing. Liquorice. Develops into creamy custard flavours

Smokehead

Smokehead is a rich, seaweedy and intensely peaty whisky. The flavour is fresh and immense, with notes of sherry, Iodine, toffee, smoke and sea salt all fighting for recognition.

Springbank 10 year old

Nose: Orchard fruit (pear) with a hint of peat, vanilla and malt.
Palate: Malt, oak, spice, nutmeg and cinnamon, vanilla essence.
Finish: Sweet with a lingering salty tingle.

Strathisla 12 year old

The palate is a lovely mid-weight in a malt that's softer than the nose initially suggests. Great momentum in the mouth with cranachan, soft baked fruits, fruit cake, syrup, apricot and malt. It dances on the tongue with a finish that bursts into life.

Talisker 10 year old

The pungent, slightly oily, peaty ruggedness of the bouquet mounts into my nostrils. Talisker is not a drink, it is an interior explosion, distilled central heating; it depth charges the parts, bangs doors and slams windows.

Tobermory

Palate:- The pleasantly surprising taste profile is medium dry with a smooth and fruity tang. Finish:- Well rounded and reassuringly rich - this golden treasure is fit for a king!

Tomatin 10 year old

MALT OF THE MONTH

A polished, mellow very approachable Speysider, Tomatin was onve the largest distillery in Scotland with 23 stills and a production capacity of 12 million litres of alcohol per year.

Tamnavulin

The palate is of medium body and very smooth. There is an oiliness that carries everything so effortlessly with notes of sherried fruits and peels and a hint of winter spice.



Tullibardine 10 year old

Rich and creamy nose. Sweet, stewed prunes. The palate is spicy, fruit pudding with a long, slightly smoky finish.
